

Basic Life Support for the HCP (BCLS): \$60.00

Textbook included. This course is designed for professional rescuers or students required to have professional rescuer certification. The course provides information on adult and pediatric CPR, two-rescuer scenarios, use of the bag-valve mask, foreign-body airway obstruction (conscious and unconscious), AED, special resuscitation situations, and other cardiopulmonary emergencies.

BCLS Renewal for HCP: \$57.00

Note: Textbook included. All participants must show current Provider card in class. Renewal of professional rescuers certification, AED and cardiopulmonary emergencies.

Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS-P): \$140.00

Textbook included. Participants must hold current BLS Healthcare Provider certification. The course covers resuscitation of cardiac arrest, MI, and CVA patients, including medications, electrical therapy, and airway management. **1st Day : 8:00-5:00;2nd Day: 8:00-12:00**

Advanced Cardiac Life Support Renewal (ACLS-Re):

\$101.50 Must hold current BLS and ACLS provider status. **Textbook required but not included in price.** Texts may be purchased for \$33.50.

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS-P): \$140.00

Textbook included. Participant must hold current BLS Healthcare Provider certification. Course covers pre-resuscitation, resuscitation and post-resuscitation procedures. Included are basic life support, airway and ventilation, vascular access, fluid therapy and medications, cardiac rhythm disturbances, trauma resuscitation and more.

Pediatric Advanced Life Support Renewal (PALS-Re):

\$101.50. Must hold current BLS and PALS provider status; **Textbook required but not included in price.** Texts may be purchased for \$35.00.

BCLS, ACLS, or PALS Instructor: \$175.00

Instructor and Provider materials included. This is a one-day course. This course prepares participants to teach both Provider and Renewal courses. **Current provider card is mandatory.**

ECG for ACLS: \$90.00 (Does not take place of ACLS)

Determining Lethal Cardiac Rhythms for ACLS. It is recommended prior to the ACLS provider course for those who need additional assistance determining rhythms.

It is strongly recommended that you register and have the materials at least a week prior to the class. Materials must be received/picked up at least one week prior to the class.

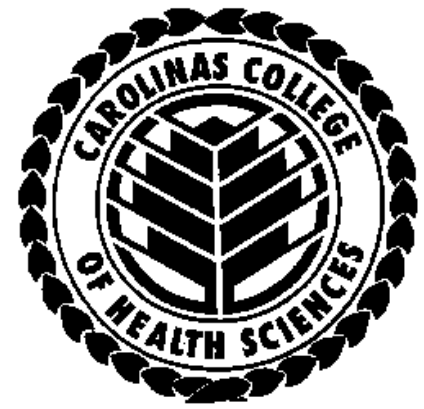
