Healing Touch Program Description:

A course of study toward a certificate of completion in Healing Touch (HT) which incorporates a variety of basic to advanced healing modalities. The program is sequenced in 6 levels allowing participants to move from beginner to advanced practitioner, expert and instructor. Certification as a Healing Touch Practitioner and Instructor is available on application following completion of course work and additional requirements.

Level I Description:

Level 1 begins with 16 -18 continuing education contact hours of instruction, allowing persons with varying backgrounds to enter, acknowledge their previous learning and to further develop concepts and skills in energy-based therapy. A strong commitment to personal growth is required.

Target Audience:

Healing Touch is a nursing based continuing education program for registered nurses, physicians, body therapists, counselors, psychotherapists, other health professionals, and individuals desiring an in-depth understanding and practice of healing work using energy based concepts.

Workshop Objectives:

- Describe the human energy system's relationship to physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual health
- Discuss energy principles basic to Healing Touch
- Assess the energy field and energy centers
- Identify a basic Healing Touch sequence
- Demonstrate specific intervention techniques used in Healing Touch
- Discuss applications of Healing Touch in personal and professional practice
