**What is Pastoral Diagnosis in Pastoral Psychotherapy?**

This continuing education course is designed to assist students in their ability to assess persons and systems utilizing learning style, developmental theory, systems, cybernetics, resiliency, and psychopathology as described in the DSM-IV-TR. Treatment strategies will be applied through case studies to religious understandings of person, functional theological norms, and pastoral roles and tasks. Participants will have the opportunity to learn to integrate the theological/spiritual lens with other perspectives of assessing person engaged in psychotherapy.
