<b>TRADITIONAL COURSE</b>	This course meets in the classroom 100% of the time.
<b>WEB-ENHANCED COURSE</b>	A web-enhanced course is a traditional course that meets in the classroom for all of regularly scheduled class time, but uses web-based technology for purposes of supplementing the course by publishing course materials, facilitating discussions, extending office hours, posting course grades, etc.
<b>HYBRID COURSE</b>	A hybrid course is defined as any course that replaces a portion of regularly scheduled class time with online activities.
<b>ONLINE COURSE</b>	An online course is defined as any course taught 100% online with no required meetings.
