Some Personal Safety/Security Tips for Students

- **Report all incidents or suspicious activity immediately to Security!**
- **Do not leave any items (yours or the College's) unattended or unsecured**
- **Wear your Carolinas HealthCare System ID badge at all times when on campus**
- **Limit what you carry and keep at least one hand free. Always have your keys ready when walking to your vehicle**
- **Pay attention to your surroundings and report any persons on campus without proper identification to Security**
- **When walking to your vehicle always use the buddy system. If no one is available to walk with you, call Security for an escort to your vehicle (Note-it may take a few minutes for an Officer to arrive, so call ahead of time if you know when you plan to leave**
